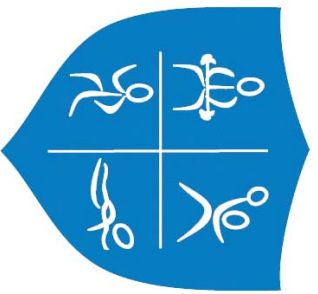
- WHEN:** March 26 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm Team Check-In

- WHO:** All Basketball Players, 3rd Grade through 12th Grade
- TEAM FEE:** \$100 Per Team (Full Payment Required at Registration).
- DIVISIONS:** Your team will be placed in a division according to the grade of your oldest team member.

- Tournament Director reserves the right to make final division changes.
 - Anyone falsifying their age or grade will be disqualified.
 - Due to the large number of teams, special scheduling requests will not be accepted.
- FORMAT:** Double-Elimination: Your team is guaranteed at least two games.
- AWARDS:** Trophies to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place teams. Free Throw Contest, Sportsmanship Awards and “Best Team Name” prizes will also be awarded.

MARCH MADNESS 3 ON 3 RULES

PLAYERS SHOULD REVIEW THESE RULES BEFORE PLAYING:

1. Teams must register at the registration table, AS A TEAM, at least 30 minutes before their 1st scheduled game.
2. Teams must be available at their court during the game preceding theirs.
3. Games are played to 15 points, win by 2, maximum 20 points, or whoever is ahead at pre-stated time limit.
4. Due to time limit, stalling will not be allowed and we will follow the rule for unsportsmanlike conduct. (See rule 15)
5. Baskets are worth 1 point each inside arc and 2 points outside of arc.
6. Ball must be “taken back” to outside of arc after each change of possession at the top of the court.
7. Ball must be “checked” and passed in at back court out of bounds line to start play after each dead ball.
8. Play stops after call is made and then ball is inbounded at top of arc
9. Fouls and free throws:
 - A) When the basket is made- count the basket and, whether the free throw is made or missed, possession goes to the defensive team.
 - B) When the basket is missed- if the free throw is made, possession goes to the defensive team. If the free throw is missed, the offensive team retains possession.
10. “Jump balls” go to defense
11. No 3 seconds
12. One time-out per team (45 seconds).
13. Running clock except for last minute of play.
14. Substitutions during dead balls only.
15. Unsportsmanlike conduct, foul language, excessive and/or and intentional fouls (not going for the ball) will not be tolerated and will result in:
 1. warning
 2. freethrow and possession to other team
 3. expulsion from game
 4. expulsion from tournament
16. Games that end in a tie at the end or the pre-stated time limit will be decided by “sudden death”. The referee will flip a coin for possession and the first team that scores wins.
17. If a player’s age is challenged and listed incorrectly on registration form, that player will be disqualified from the tournament and games won will be forfeited.
18. All fouls and violations will be played out-of-bounds at the top of the court.
19. A ball out-of-bounds will be taken at the top of the court.
20. Main Court Rule Only:

After 7 fouls- teams start shooting free throws. The player can chose to shoot at the free throw line for 1 point. If he makes it, the ball goes to the defensive team. If he misses it, the offensive team keeps possession. If he wants to try for 2 points, the shot is attempted at the top of the key. Regardless of whether the shot is made/missed, the ball will be awarded to the other time.

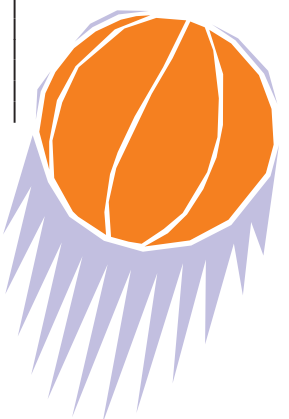
